

Enhanced Farm Tractors (Non Pace)

These Tractors are not allowed to enter Farm Stock Pace!

Enhanced Tractors are stock appearing tractors with enhancements to create more horsepower and pulling ability than similar stock models.

Classes include: 4,500, 5,500, 6,500, 7,500, 9,500, 11,500, 13,500 and 15,500 lbs

11,500, 13 500 and 15,500 lbs Enhanced Farm Tractors can only pull in the Enhanced Class or Hot Stock Classes. These tractors are **not allowed to pull in Farm Stock Classes.

1. Maximum 3000 RPM, No water injection allowed.
2. Max Turbo size allowed is 3x3 and no intercooler.
3. One fuel type only. No Nitrous or LP.
4. No cut tires.
5. No down draft carbs allowed.
6. Minimum of 3 tractors to have prizes, but classes will run with less.
7. Injection pumps of OEM make for that model year.
8. Electric or Belt driven pumps allowed.
9. Must have tire fenders.
10. All weights must be secured.
11. Tractors are suggested to have a kill switch, but not mandatory.
12. Must have stock frame no custom frames allowed.
13. Engine must be OEM type or equivalent to that model tractor.
14. All Tractors are subject to Tech Inspection.
15. All decisions by Track Official are Final
16. Must have working seat belts.
17. Drawbar is to be stationary in all directions with not more than 1" of movement in any one direction. Maximum height of drawbar to be 20". Length of drawbar to be no less than 24" from center of rear axle. Drawbar must be equipped with a steel hitching device not more than 1" thickness and minimum 3/4" diameter opening. Cross sectional thickness must be 7/8" minimum. Pulling point may not be more than 1 1/2" from back edge of hitching device. PTPA suggests fastening hitching device with one 7/8" or two 5/8" bolt and/or bolts. No top bracing except complete factory setup. No quick hitch type adapters allowed on tractors.
